### Pilot Joint Call on Innovation



The ERA.Net RUS Pilot Joint Call on Innovation will be open for proposal submission from 15 February 2011 until 15 April 2011.

The goal of the call is to create long-term research collaboration in the field of innovation between EU Member States/ Associated Countries to FP7 and Russia. Innovative research collaboration of a high standard between teams from EU Member States and/or Associated Countries and Russia will be supported through open competition.

EU-Russia collaborative innovation projects can be funded in the research areas, which are thematically assigned to innovative technologies of high utilization potential and of particular importance for the EU as well as for Russia.

'Innovation Projects' refers to joint R&D projects designed to lead to innovative products, services or processes of significant economic and/or societal value.

The participating countries are:

- Germany
- Greece
- Israel
- Russia
- Switzerland
- Turkey

Eligible consortia must comprise a minimum of three eligible institutions from three different countries, of which at least one small innovative Russian company, and at least one company from an EU MS/AC.

Project duration maybe up to 24 months.

The overall budget of the ERA.Net RUS Pilot Joint Call on Innovation is EUR 2.980.000 plus additional money from INTAS.
